

The Lower Lonsdale area is thriving and it has, excellent accessibility from public transportation like the Skytrain and Seabus. The area has a vibrant, dynamic, active feeling, great food and drink downstairs, fantastic fellowship options for after church, an active growing neighbourhood called Yaletown North. It is a destination for recreation with a park nearby, many special festivals and events at the Quay. Literally thousands of people live, and travel thru this area daily and it's easy to find!
